The below are estimates and actual cost will vary.

We understand how important a U.S. clinical experience is to your medical education. Planning early allows you to budget appropriately. We want to make an AMO clinical experiences obtainable no matter the cost.

### Per four weeks/month:

# WHY IS AMO GOOD FOR YOU AS A GRADUATE OR DOCTOR?

While graduates aren't able to participate in a hands-on rotation, you can still gain experience with the American healthcare system through observerships. Most importantly, participating in this rotation means you can develop a relationship with a U.S. doctor who can serve as a mentor for the rest of your professional career—even when back in your home country.

At the end of your rotation, you will have the opportunity to ask for a letter of recommendation. These LORs can either help you when you apply for the residency program in the U.S. or help strengthen your C.V. for your work back home.

While many companies set up observerships with just shadowing, our observerships involve differential diagnosis and case presentations, and our physicians know that visitors are attending for the purpose of obtaining a letter of recommendation for the Match.
