



CASE STUDY AMO OPPORTUNITIES

Florida International University

Finding U.S. clinical rotations can be a daunting task. This is especially true for international medical students and graduates. In 2020, Florida International University and AMO Opportunities established a partnership to make U.S. clinical rotations more accessible to these trainees.

Prior to this partnership, if international medical students and graduates wanted to rotate with FIU, they applied through the website and competed with thousands of other students. With AMO, trainees have a “fast lane” through the process and are guaranteed a spot if they meet the program’s requirements.

AMO hosts FIU programs on its clinical rotation marketplace based on the capacity that the university provides. Trainees who apply to FIU’s programs through the AMO platform bypass the traditional away-rotation application process while maintaining the integrity of FIU’S application requirements. AMO handles the administrative and marketing workload, allowing FIU to expand its clinical availability.

Expanding Clinical Capacity

In 2020, FIU onboarded programs to AMO's platform in 19 specialties and subspecialties. This created the infrastructure needed to host cohort rotations from universities around the globe that are partnered with AMO.

Programs are offered in person as observerships or hands-on rotations, making them ideal for both medical students and medical graduates. As COVID-19 travel and social distancing restrictions ease, FIU and AMO will continue ensuring global access to medical education through cohort rotations.
