In 2022, IMGs who participated in an AMO rotation matched at a higher rate than non-U.S. and U.S. IMGs.

A Match Advantage

Following the 2022 Match, we asked 2,000+ past AMO trainees if they matched into a U.S. residency program.

We found that IMGs who participated in an AMO rotation matched this year at **80.6%**, which is higher than the 2022 Match average for both non-U.S. IMGs (**58.1%**) and U.S. IMGs (**61.4%**).
