



# VIRTUAL-INTERACTIVE ROTATIONS FOR COHORTS

*These virtual rotations from Weissman Medical Education are designed to develop your students' research or clinical skills and strengthen their candidacy for any residency program.*

## BENEFITS

The virtual programs found on the next page offer the benefit of accessibility for students around the world. Other benefits are listed below.

### ***A New Jersey-Based Hospital***

A third of students return to their clinical training hospitals for residency. New Jersey is one of the friendliest IMG states, meaning this rotation could help improve Match chances.

### ***10 Weekly Asynchronous Learning Hours***

As an education-focused experience, the internal medicine program's weekly 10 asynchronous hours allow students to learn on their own schedule.

### ***Publication Opportunities***

The research rotation's emphasis on meaningful clinical research gives students the opportunity to coauthor articles for publication to *PubMed*, *Scopus*, and other indexed journals.

## DISCOUNTS

The baseline cost of each program is \$3,499 per student for a four-week rotation. Cohorts can deduct from that overall cost.

## VIRTUAL-INTERACTIVE RESEARCH POSITION

*with Program Director, TRI Internship  
Hackensack Meridian Health Palisades Medical Center*

Your students will conduct clinical research virtually while working directly with two internal medicine physicians based in New Jersey. Each student will have the opportunity to coauthor an article (case reports, retrospective study, and meta-analysis abstracts) for publishing to *PubMed*, *Scopus*, and other indexed journals.

The rotation includes daily lectures on research methodology, biomedical literature writing, hypothesis-generating data, and study appraisal.

Demonstrating research ability is a huge differentiator in residency applications. This program is a great way for students to build that experience from the comfort of home or school. There may even be opportunities to present findings at national medical conferences.

## VIRTUAL-INTERACTIVE INTERNAL MEDICINE ROTATION

*with Program Director, TRI Internship  
Hackensack Meridian Health Palisades Medical Center*

Across 40 synchronous hours with the doctor and 40 asynchronous hours each month, your students will have the opportunity to build a working and meaningful differential diagnosis for typical cases seen in hospitals. They will also have the chance to earn two merit-based LoRs.

Upon completion of this experience, trainees will have a broad grasp of hospital-based medicine and be able to apply their basic science knowledge on a clinical level. They will also be prepared for core rotations and externship rotations in the hospital setting. Moreover, this serves as a basis for excelling as an intern once residency begins because students will have mastered the diagnostics and management skills needed to work as a trainee on a clinical level.
