

#### Genders Our Visitors Identify As




#### Top Countries



Total Rotation Bookings




#### Most Popular Months

### Favorite Programs


Virtual clinical experiences remained popular in 2021, but it was also nice to have trainees back in person! Here are the top 10 programs of the past year.
